## SEMINAR OVERVIEW

Participants will assess their leadership skills in several key areas for the practice of leadership and management. Using key leadership theories and an interactive style of applying these theories to practical situations, we will explore the leadership skills, traits and styles of the participants.

Based on their personal and professional experiences, participants will develop a personal profile of their leadership skills, traits and styles utilizing leadership self-assessments and inventories. They will identify their own core competencies and areas for further growth and development.

Participants will examine the benefits and challenges of certain leadership styles in a variety of organizational settings and leadership contexts.



## Benefits to Participants:

This will be a practical, hands-on leadership workshop that will challenge participants to assess their current strengths and weaknesses, identify strategies for self-improvement and develop a plan to learn and grow as professional leaders.

### Upon completion of the seminar, participants will:

- Identify a personal profile of their strengths and weaknesses as a leader
- Explore five practices used by successful leaders
- Develop a personal plan to live out these five leadership practices
- Understand the range of leadership skills and traits needed in various situations
- Apply organizational leadership models to the practice of leadership
- Gain a richer understanding of organizational life and leadership
- Add four tools to their leadership toolbox
- Live out the core values of servant leadership.

- Model the way
- Encourage the heart
- Challenge the process
- Enable others to act
- Inspire a shared vision

Dr. Dan R. Ebener has been practicing leadership and management teaching for over thirty years. He has been teaching leadership at St. Ambrose University in Davenport, Iowa, USA for over ten years.

He has a doctorate in business and masters degrees in education, business and social work. He teaches courses in leadership, strategic planning and conflict resolution. He has provided leadership consultation to over thirty groups in the last three years, and he has traveled to about forty countries, mostly on mission trips.
